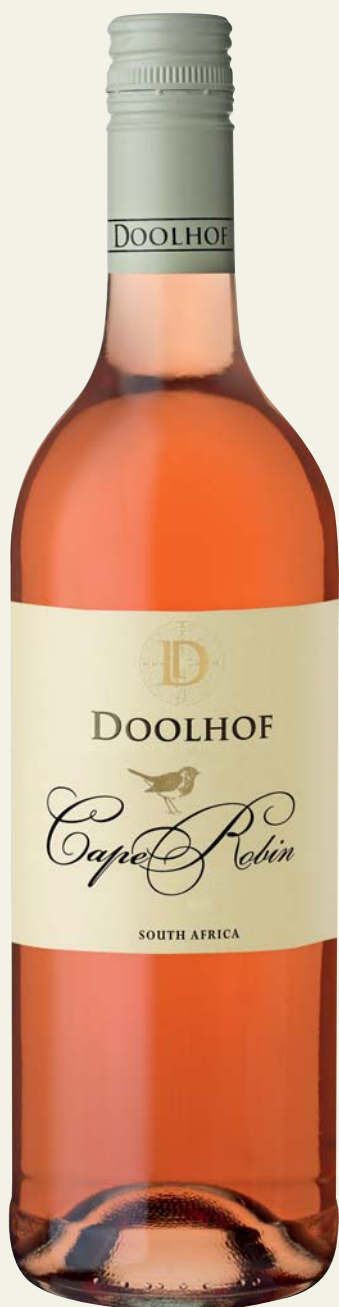


Doolhof Cape Range Cape Robin 2009

**A Cape Rosé with its abundant fruit
synonymous with warm summer days.**



Tasting Notes: A rich salmon coloured Rosé with orange hues. Very floral on the nose with strawberries, honey, melon and even candy floss. This mélange of rich fruit is evident on the palate with balanced acidity and a full, dry finish.

Winemaker's Notes: The grapes for this wine were selected from different vineyards, harvested especially early to obtain less sugar leading to lower alcohol. Skin contact for four hours was given to obtain a light salmon colour. The Merlot and Pinotage were fermented separately and then blended. This made a wine with an abundance of flavours and aromas. Stabilization, filtration and bottling took place in December 2009.
